- Must be a senior (12th Grade) student
- One person per spot
- One application per person (any duplications will be disqualified)
- \$150 per person, per semester (cash or check payable to Samohi with ID# in the memo section)
- The submitting of this application allows the applicant one ticket in the parking lottery.
- Must have:
 - Valid driver's license
 - Current registration
 - Proof of insurance
 - Signed Parking Agreement
- Friday, September 10, 2010 – Senior Parking Lottery Applications due to the Activities Office by 3:30 pm sharp. Late applications will not be accepted.
- Tuesday, September 14, 2010 – Senior Parking Lottery drawing will be held in Main Quad during lunch.
- Wednesday, September 15, 2010 – Senior Parking privileges begins if requirements are complete.
- Friday, September 17, 2010 – Last day to turn in payment and paperwork at lunch or after school.
- Parking Permits can be revoked with no refunds. Please see Parking Agreement.

SENIOR PARKING AGREEMENT

Although you are currently applying for Senior Parking Lottery please know that your ability to park on campus is a privilege, not a right and in order to keep this privilege you must agree to the following terms and conditions:

- You are responsible for maintaining a valid driver's license, current vehicle registration and automobile insurance.
- All authorized vehicles parking on campus must possess a current parking permit. The permit must be in plain view in the lower driver side back window.
- Your registered vehicle must be parked in your assigned parking space only. If your assigned parking space is occupied by another vehicle, you must report it to Security immediately. You will be instructed as to what alternative parking is available for that day only.
- You do not have the authority to authorize other students to use your assigned parking space in your absence. Parking permits are NOT TRANSFERABLE to another vehicle or another student. If a decal is found on another vehicle, both parties loose decals and face disciplinary action.
- If you drive any vehicle other than the one of record it must be reported immediately. Proper paperwork must be submitted and approved within five (5) days, along with a \$15.00 filing fee, and you must return the parking permit sticker from your previous vehicle.
- All laws must be followed while on campus or immediate school area:
 - Vehicle will carry only the number of passengers for which it was designed.
 - Passengers must wear individual seat belts.
 - Must exhibit safe, courteous driving and follow all traffic laws (no more than five (5) miles per hour within parking lot).
 - No vehicle grand standing/exhibition/cruising or showing off unsafely in or around campus.
 - No confiscating students off campus (both within the vehicle or in the trunk).
 - No alcohol, narcotics, paraphernalia, or weapons in vehicle.
 - Drivers under the age of 18 may not use a wireless telephone, pager, laptop or any other electronic communication or mobile services device to speak or text while driving in any manner, even "hands-free." EXCEPTION: Permitted in emergency situations to call police, fire or medical authorities (VC §23124).
- Vehicle will not be used as a locker or storage as parking lot is off limit other than before/after school and during lunch only.
- Santa Monica High School and Santa Monica-Malibu Unified School district is not responsible or liable for any damage to, or loss of vehicle or personal property. Students will keep their vehicles locked at all time while parked on campus.
- **All students in your vehicle exiting parking lot must have their current student ID cards with current off campus stickers (Off Campus Lunch Pass or No 4th, 5th or 6th Period) or Office Pass to leave campus, out and ready to show prior to approaching security.**
- In an effort to support the Tardy Policy, any student parking in the Senior Lot will adhere to the following policy:
 - If tardy once, parking privilege is revoked for that day only.
 - If tardy more than three times, parking privilege is revoked for the entire semester and the money will not be refunded.
- Students who abuse the tardy policy, cut class, and/or have discipline problem or on academic probation are subject to revocation of parking permit.

We have read and agree to the terms and conditions listed on this form and understand that failure to adhere to these terms run the risk of losing parking privilege. We further understand that the Semester Parking Fees paid will not be returned in whole or in part if parking permit is revoked (No Refunds). Funds will be considered a donation to the school.
